Skills Assessment Phase

- Testing station ice layout improvements for process efficiency
- Increased training for assessment facilitators

Scrimmage Assessment Phase

- Increased paid independent evaluators to ensure fair evaluation
- Increased training and guidelines for coach evaluators
- Goaltenders to be evaluated by dedicated goalie evaluators
- Evaluation scrimmages to take place concurrently to condense overall evaluation timeline
- Timeline adjustments to effectively integrate players released from AA/AAA
- Increased flexibility to advance players demonstrating advancement early in the scrimmage assessment process

Goaltender Evaluation Process Overview

New: In addition to the goaltending introduction and development programming enhancements this year, SVMHA will also be offering goaltender training to prepare for the skills assessment.

Goaltenders will attend a Technical Skills Assessment session

Scrimmage Assessment Phase

- Like players, the Skills Assessment results will be used to place goaltenders into associated group levels for the scrimmage assessment
- When there are more than 3 Goaltenders in a peer group, goalies will be evaluated by dedicated goaltender evaluators during the scrimmage assessment

• Chill Goaltenders will attend a Technical Skills Assessment session if there are more than four registers in the age group


